Pointers to particularities of the separate lists of succession, which have no influence on their authenticity:

**List No. 1: Armenian Uniate**

For Archbishop Leo Chechemian mentioned under no. 137 the day of consecration repeatedly is sometimes indicated as 23.04.1878 and sometimes as 28.04.1878.

**List No. 2: Antiochian**

In some lists the Patriarch mentioned under No. 25 is missing: Beatus Meletius of the year 352.

**List No. 3: Chaldean Uniate**

Patriarch Johannes appointed by Pope Pius VIII on 5 July 1830 is called the VIII or the IX in several lists. Moreover, in this succession (no. 7) Mar Anthony (1917) is called in several lists: Lebferner, or Lefebre, or Lefberner.

**List No. 7: Old Catholic**

The Old Catholic list of the 'See of Utrecht' always mentions the Archbishop of Utrecht (1-71), who in general received his consecration from the Bishop of Haarlem or Deventer. This was taken into account in the list no. 9. The Old Catholic Succession overlaps the Apostolic Succession, from which the Old Catholics can additionally trace their Apostolic Succession.

**These lists of succession were examined on account of the different successions and found corresponding to the sources.**
