

CHALDEAN UNIATE LINE of SUCCESSION

According to tradition saint Thomas the Apostle is the actual founder of Christianity in Seleucia. St Addai (Thaddeus, one of the 72 disciples) was allegedly sent to King Abgar in Edessa, Mesopotamia, by Apostle Thomas, who cured the king and preached the Gospel to him. (*NB:* The Chaldean Uniate Succession, which is in papal obedience, has been fully recognised by Rome.)

Residence in Mossoul:

Pope Pius VIII appointed Johannes VIII Hormez Patriarch of Babylon on 5 July 1830 with patriarchal see in Mossoul (Iraq). Mossoul is next to Bagdad the see of the Chaldean Uniate Patriarchs. The Chaldean Patriarch of Babylon has been elected by the Bishops since 1869 and confirmed by the Pope in Rome. The Patriarchate is responsible to the Congregatio pro Ecclesia Orient as well as to the Apostolic Delegates of Mesopotamia and Persia respectively.
