

Assumption of Mary The Prayer of the Rosary

My beloved, the Assumption of Mary – it is an incomprehensible, eternal and tremendous feast in Heaven. There such events are no time-limited incidents, they last forever. And we are allowed to join this everlasting feast by saying with a joyful and solemn heart: „Hail Mary, You are full of grace, the LORD is with You; You are blessed among women and blessed is the fruit of Your womb, JESUS.“ And while realizing Mary’s greatness we dare ask: „Holy Mary, Mother of GOD, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death. Amen!“

Mary, Free from Original Sin

Death is a result of original sin. Mary was free from original sin and therefore also free from death. So her death was not really death but a rapture, a transition into Heaven. It is true that Mary is Co-Redemptrix but the SAVIOUR had already suffered death. Consequently, her death was no longer required.

Mary’s Dormition

As her passing away drew near, Mary said to the Apostle John: „That is why I feel that I shall cease to be on the Earth, I through excess of love, as He (the SAVIOUR) died through excess of sorrow. Well! The measure of my capacity of loving is full. My soul and my body are no longer able to contain it! Love overflows from it, it submerges me and raises me at the same time towards Heaven, towards God, My Son. And His voice says to me: ‚Come! Come out! Ascend to our Throne

and to our Trine embrace!' The Earth, what surrounds me, disappears in the bright light that comes to me from Heaven! Noises are drowned by this celestial voice! My moment for the divine embrace has come, my dear John!" (from "The Poem of the Man-God", volume 5)

After Mary had passed away, John speaks talking to himself, as if Mary could still hear him: „But are you really dead? Dead as every man dies? No! I feel it is not so. Your spirit is no longer in you, in your body, and in that respect we could say it is death. But by the way your passage took place, I think that yours is only a temporary separation of your soul, without sin and full of grace, from your most pure and virginal body. It must be so! It is so! How and when the reunion will take place and life will come back to you, I do not know. But I am so certain of this that I will remain here beside you until God, either with His word or with His action, will show me the truth on your destiny." (from "the Poem of the Man-God", volume 5)

Assumption of Mary

So Mary did not really die. Her soul left her body and returned home to GOD. After about three days Angels came down from Heaven. The ceiling of her room opened and when the Angels lifted Mary's body from the resting place, it was transfigured. It became shining, was made young again and floated into Heaven glorified, accompanied by the holy Angels. Quite similar was the Ascension of her Son.

JESUS came to meet her from Heaven and accompanied her to the throne of the Most Holy TRINITY. We cannot imagine what joy it was: Mary – glorified, with body and soul, at a young age, enthroned as Queen of Heaven. An unequalled feast of joy!

How do you imagine Heaven? Many think that the Angels in Heaven float around like birds. But then, how does it work: JESUS, Mary, st Joseph as well as several other Saints are in Heaven body and soul. They would fall

down if they were not standing on firm ground. No, my beloved, in Heaven everything is much grander but also much more natural as it is here on earth. The Prayer of the Rosary

Well, my beloved, honour Mary, love her. It is worth giving up a few things. Start with giving Mary one or the other 'Hail Mary'. However, do not just rattle off this prayer but make it a calm solemn greeting. Every 'Hail Mary' is like a rose opening up that you offer to Mary as a present. After a while you may wish to give her more roses or even a bunch of roses. That is the actual prayer of the rosary. The whole Marian psalter of the Rosary would be a bunch of 150 roses divided in 15 mysteries, which in turn are divided in the joyful, sorrowful and glorious mysteries.

At some places where Mary appeared, she asked: „Pray the Rosary every day!" Seize the opportunities during the day to pray just one 'Hail Mary' every now and then. For not everyone is capable of praying persistently and not everyone has time to pray fifty 'Hail Marys' or more every day. Then you will experience that Mary will look after you as well.

If you do not find your way to Mary, then I recommend: go to st Joseph! He was the first venerator of Mary. And she, the Queen of Angels, the Queen of Heaven, was perfectly obedient to Joseph according to the customs of the time though Joseph wanted to be her servant because he realized her greatness.
