Sometimes I have a feeling that some people are falling a little short of their inner and outer preparation to receive the SAVIOUR. Are you aware that you are receiving GOD into your heart? Reciting your sins to Him and at the same time carrying on like before would be superficial, even lukewarm. Nor should you ever forget to show your appreciation: „LORD, it is just unimaginable – I can be with You! I thank You!“ You can say that every day, every minute. Then you will certainly enter into the eternal beatitude of Heaven one day! Amen!

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The Seven Sacraments GOD's help

My beloved, we are all weakened because of original sin and are inclined to sin. Furthermore, the tempter is always lying in wait. People are burdened by endless trouble! GOD knows, He therefore offers us His help. In the first place this help of GOD comes in the seven holy Sacraments.

The Seven Holy Sacraments

„You are My beloved child, I accept you (Baptism).
I strengthen you with the power of My HOLY SPIRIT (Confirmation).
I am the Bread of eternal life to you (Eucharist).
I forgive you, you can start anew (Confession).
I comfort and heal you (Anointing of the Sick).
I send you, be a blessing to the people (Holy Orders).
I am with you in happy and in difficult times (Matrimony).“

Knowing that there is plenty of water beneath the earth is of little help to someone who is dying of thirst. He needs access to this water – a well. The Sacraments, given by GOD, administered by men, are like wells from which the water of Heaven can be drawn.

The Sacrament of Redemption

Holy Confession is one of the greatest gifts of the SAVIOUR to His Church.

John 20,21ff: „Again Jesus said: ‚Peace be with you! As the Father has sent me, I am sending you.‘ And with that he breathed on them and

said: „Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive the sins of anyone, their sins are forgiven; if you do not forgive them, they are not forgiven.“

This Sacrament of Confession has found itself in a major crisis. On the one hand, in many places it is no longer offered by the Church or merely offered on inquiry. On the other hand, it is rejected by the people: „Well, after all, I did not steal anything, I did not kill anyone ... I do not need to confess!“ In addition, people often have a wrong and one-sided image of GOD and of man: „We will all go to Heaven because we are so good!“ People lack any sense of guilt.

Faith tells us: GOD created us out of love and called us to an unlimited, happy life with Him. GOD allows us to choose this happiness freely: He takes our conduct of life as a yes or no to His offer. We ourselves decide on our final future! However, the majority of mankind hardly care for GOD's incomprehensible divine love, which He offers us in the Sacraments. Man no longer pays attention to his calling as a child of GOD, instead he constantly neglects and offends his Creator. That is why man nowadays acts in such a destructive and exploitative way.

Visit of the SAVIOUR

If I tell people that I am coming to visit them, some women spring-clean their whole house. And if the SAVIOUR comes to visit you? – I am only His servant. – What will it look like in the dwelling of your heart? You can do some spring-cleaning here as well. This spiritual spring-cleaning is done most thoroughly by making a good confession. If you have confessed in this way, then you may go to Holy Communion with a good conscience and in great joy in order to receive the SAVIOUR in Flesh and Blood:

John 6,51: „I am the living bread that came down from heaven. Whoever eats of this bread will live forever. This bread is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world.“

„From the lips of children you have ordained praise!“

I have recently read a very charming story of a four-year-old girl called Clare. She was the fifth of eight children. When Clare's mother had returned from the communion-rail back to her pew, Clare leaned against her breast and said: „JESUS is with you now, I want to be near Him.“ Soon after her mother asked the parish priest if little Clare could go to early

Communion. When the priest asked the child: „Do you want JESUS to come to you?“ Clare answered: „No, JESUS wants to come to me!“

Does it not prove to be true once again:

Matt 11,25: „I praise you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because you have hidden these things from the wise and learned, and revealed them to little children!“

From the lips of this child we hear the deepest truth in greatest simplicity: The SAVIOUR Himself wants to come to us.

GOD Takes His Abode in Your Heart

When you receive the SAVIOUR in Holy Communion, you will eat the consecrated wafer bread or let it dissolve on your tongue. He enters into your heart right away as soon as the Host dissolves, and He goes up in you in the same way as He passed through closed doors after His resurrection. Is it not unbelievable that we can receive GOD, the Creator of the whole Universe, and this tremendous power in this way with our mouths and into our hearts? Incomprehensible – only GOD's love can do that!

John 14,23: „Anyone who loves me will obey my teaching. My Father will love them, and we will come to them and make our home with them.“

Position of the Hands after Communion

Once I expressed a wish that, when you have received the SAVIOUR at the communion-rail, you may return to your pew with your hands crossed on your chest, thus embracing the SAVIOUR in adoration. Now I noticed that some do not dare to touch their chest with their hands for fear of leaving marks on their clothes when touching them with their sweaty hands. And so I give new orders: who wants to worship the SAVIOUR in this way by embracing Him can, of course, continue to do so. But who has this particular problem, might also just fold his hands as in prayer and return to his seat in silent adoration.
