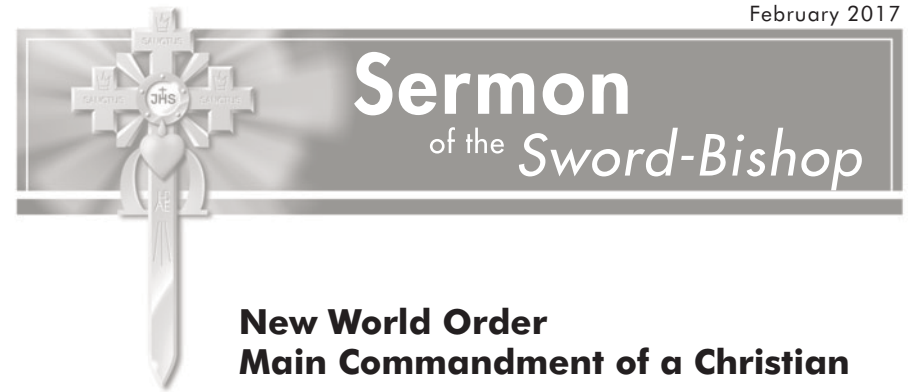

New World Order Main Commandment of a Christian

My dearly beloved! Yesterday I read an interesting sentence: „I would be happier to die in JESUS' hands than to be healed by Satan!“ Good sentence!

Today there is quite a lot of talk about the new world order. Such nonsense! A world order – who has the right to impose an order on the world? I think the Creator: GOD! And He has given us an order! In that case, none other is needed. If someone believes he needs to meddle with GOD's order, you can tell in advance that it is not good.

10 Commandments and Main Commandment

But what kind of order did GOD give to us? They are the 10 Commandments. First of all, you will have to familiarise yourself with them that you may know what they say. We put that into our brain, into our heads, into our mind. And then comes the Main Commandment and that should be put into our heart, because the heart is the oven. In it should be the fire, the fervour of the HOLY SPIRIT. After all, it says: „You are temples of the HOLY SPIRIT!“ And when this oven, the heart, is burning, the heat will go upwards and liquefy this grey matter, the mind, and then it is fine.

What do the 10 Commandments say? I will name them: The 1st Commandment: „I am the LORD your GOD! You shall have no other gods before Me!“, neither any football idols, nor actor idols

as deities. If they are good, then look at all their skills in amazement, but do not have them as gods. Today it often happens especially with young girls, who pass out on seeing some idol or other, for example a singer. But how does it look when you say: „FATHER, You who are in Heaven!“ or when you speak to the HOLY SPIRIT, whom you carry within you?

Then we have the 2nd Commandment: „You shall not take the Name of GOD in vain.“ How many swearwords are continually heard with GOD’s Name? – The 3rd Commandment says: „Remember to keep holy the LORD’s Day.“ The 4th Commandment: „Honour your father and your mother so that you may live long and that it may go well with you.“ Fifth: „You shall not murder.“ If it said “not kill,” we would not be allowed to swat a gnat any more, would not be allowed to eat meat any more, no little fishies, although the SAVIOUR Himself also caught some. Correctly, therefore, it says “not murder.” Anything more than is needed, is murder. The 6th Commandment says: „You shall not commit adultery.“ Seventh: „You shall not steal.“ Eighth: „You shall not bear false witness against your neighbour.“ Ninth: „You shall not covet your neighbour’s wife.“ And tenth: „You shall not covet your neighbour’s goods.“

Those would be the 10 Commandments. They should be put into our minds. One must always have them in oneself. But now comes that which the fire in our heart should always be ablaze for, the Main Commandment: „You shall love the LORD your GOD with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength!“ This is the first Commandment in the Main Commandment. They already had this in the Old Covenant and JESUS repeated it to the Apostles. But then there is a second one in the Main Commandment, which is like the first: „You shall love your neighbour as yourself.“

This love is the greatest strength with which we can cling to GOD. And I say it as the SAVIOUR does: „If only this love were ablaze in you!“ She is a power! Just consider what strength this love has within herself. Look at the SAVIOUR on the Cross. What made Him do this? Merely His burning love for us brought Him to the Cross, that He could bear it.

Giving Satisfaction

GOD said to Adam in Paradise: „Look, I am giving you all this. Rule it wisely, tend it. From all trees you may eat, but you must not eat from this tree in the middle of the garden!“ Adam also passed this on to Eve. But they still ate from the forbidden tree, because the Evil One through the snake – at that time it was not a snake yet, but a wonderful animal, Eve’s favourite animal – had said to Eve that they would be like GOD. Consequently, through the Fall of Man, the creature made by GOD told his Creator: „I will not do now what You want, I want to become just like You!“

Now, of course, we ought to know what GOD is like. His greatness defies measurement! The whole universe cannot contain Him. And now a little two-legger says: „I will not do now what You want! I want to become just like You!“ That is such a lese-majesty offence that it actually cannot be made amends for, least of all by a human being, because man is only human. Because GOD is billions, billions of kilometres higher, infinitely higher than man. How is there supposed to be a possibility for making satisfaction? It would take a GOD for the satisfaction to be of equal value. But GOD did not sin after all, man sinned. Only one possibility remained: It had to be a human being, because man had sinned, but at the same time he also had to be GOD, therefore GOD-Man. And JESUS made it possible. He became GOD-Man through Mary, the Virgin. Now the satisfaction was of equal value. – JESUS took for all of us upon Himself as Man and GOD our sins which were, are, and will be. Through His Precious Blood, the Heavenly FATHER was reconciled, and in the power of the HOLY SPIRIT we are enabled to accept it for our salvation. Do we not have reason to love GOD? Can we actually still consider asking for things, bearing in mind what He did for us, for every single human being?
