

Sermon

of the *Sword-Bishop*

Patron of the World Peace St. Nicholas of Flüe 600th Anniversary of his Birthday

My dearly beloved! The important thing today is: Live at peace with one another! How should we be able to ask for peace for the world, if we do not start with ourselves? I know that one cannot always have peace so easily if the wicked neighbour or my own housemates are not pleased. But then, do not get worked up, keep calm, leave it to GOD. It may take a long time for you to chase a fly and finally catch it. Just take a drop of honey for it and then it will surely come. It is the same with religion. – See to it that you do not return evil for evil, which is a common practice today. Always chase after the good and not the evil! Always be of good cheer! Live at peace with one another. – However, I cannot love my neighbour if I do not like him, unless I love GOD and I see that GOD loves him also because he, too, is a child of GOD. And perhaps GOD says to me: „Please help him to find Me again!“

To me GOD's love is beyond all telling – impossible to describe, on earth beyond understanding because it is a heavenly love. GOD is GOD! We cannot fathom nor grasp GOD. An example: A gnat says to an elephant: „You'd better watch out! I am going to fight you!“ This is just a tiny comparison of the difference between a human being and GOD. He is so almighty that we cannot understand it with that pea-sized head of ours on top of our neck. He is so powerful. He can do whatever He wills. He only says: „Let there be!“ and it is. He has neither beginning nor end. We, human beings, cannot understand it, therefore we say “GOD”.

If this love of GOD or how to love GOD could be explained, we would have to say: GOD gives this love if you seek. „Seek and you will find!“ the SAVIOUR said. But where? Well, you just have to find out for yourselves. Look for such priests who themselves love GOD because only such a priest possesses the fire to enkindle the hearts of others, if only they are willing. Despite all the misery in the world you can be in touch with GOD and be happy in all suffering. That is my wish for everyone. – Sometimes I am asked to heal a person who, however, does not bother about GOD and His Commandments at all. My dearly beloved, I am not a faith healer of any kind, I am just the instrument of GOD – whether you like it or not, it must please GOD. Am I supposed to cure a person who afterwards uses his health to keep on sinning, to continue offending GOD? Then after his death he will certainly be given an even harder time than before. It is love when I do not cure him. Unfortunately, the Bible does not say that JESUS, too, refused to cure many sick persons because they would have used their health against GOD.

600 Years St. Nicholas of Flüe

On behalf of GOD, I would love to recommend to you and particularly to the whole world a special Saint: St. Nicholas of Flüe. He is responsible for the whole world because he has been appointed by Pope Pius XII as Patron of the world peace. How much does the world need St. Nicholas of Flüe because the imminent danger of war is very great.

St. Nicholas of Flüe was a Swiss, Roman Catholic, father of ten children, a farmer by profession as well as a councillor, judge, officer in war. They wanted to confer on him the highest political office of head of the cantonal government, which he refused. Having seen all the falsehood in politics, he resigned from all offices. GOD guided him from childhood onwards. He was able, for example, afterwards at a relative's house to recount the names of those who had been present at his Baptism and what they had spoken amongst one another. More and more GOD drew Nicholas to Himself. Although there was a won-

derful relationship in their family, also in his marriage to his wife Dorothy, GOD brought him to the point – I know what it means – of increasingly only wanting to contemplate GOD, to become one harmonious being with Him. In this way, his famous prayer was created: „My LORD and my GOD, take away from me everything that keeps me from You! My LORD and my GOD, give me everything that furthers and brings me nearer to You! My LORD and my GOD, take me away from myself“ – that is, take My own self from me – „and make me wholly Your own!“

It is also my particularly beloved prayer, but I say: „My LORD and my GOD, take away from me everything that keeps me and through me all men from You! My LORD and my GOD, give me everything that furthers and brings me and through me all men nearer to You! My LORD and my GOD, take me away from myself and make me through Mary's hands wholly Your own. Amen!“ There are people who are afraid to say such a prayer. „Oh, might He perhaps take this or that from me? Or will my husband or wife die or the children?“ What kind of attitude do you have towards GOD? Is He not our FATHER? Does He actually love us?

Switzerland Protected during World War II

My name is also Nikolaus. My parents gave me this name on account of St. Nicholas of Flüe. St. Nicholas of Flüe is even more famous abroad than he is in Switzerland. Those who have the opportunity to go on a pilgrimage not just to Sachseln where he is laid out, but also to Flüeli-Ranft, where he lived, and to enter his hermitage cell, will experience something. There is such a great peace – that makes it obvious that he is the Patron of peace.
